#### **Warehouse Associate**

#### Job Summary:

This position is responsible for providing reliable customer service and accurate inventory. This includes checking stock, getting products to customers, record keeping, and maintaining safety, security and integrity. The specific duties and responsibilities may change or be increased as assigned and include, but are not limited to:

## **Principal Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Pulling, packing and delivering orders to customers. Preparing orders for shipment adhering to Super Stone and DOT requirements.
- Counting inventory, stocking shelves, and organizing products.
- Manufacturing and packing products. Operating motorized equipment such as forklifts, mixing machines, bagging machines, front end loader, pallet wrapping, and pallet regulations.
- Provide occasional coverage for nearby locations as needed.
- Receiving, unloading, and checking deliveries. Following shipping and receiving procedures and complete necessary paperwork.
- Transporting orders via small truck or larger flatbed truck. Ensuring order is accurate and received or delivered to proper parties (as needed).
- Assisting with setup, material prepetition, and cleanup of seminars.
- Maintaining a clean and organized warehouse including trash removal, lawn maintenance, and facility clean-up. Adhere to health and safety operating procedures.
